CIRP is committed to providing training and education to the organized industry not only for those who are struggling with mental health and addiction issues but to the contractors, the unions, health and welfare plans too.

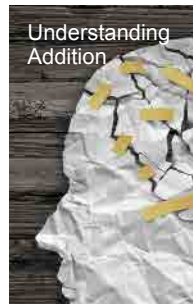
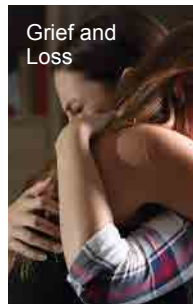
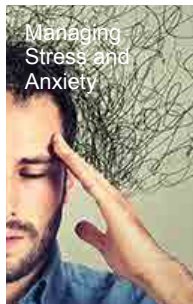
Naloxone Training – We offer free opioid overdose response training and free Take Home Naloxone kits (THN) to EVERYONE. We are committed to getting as many kits

BIOPSYCHOSOCIAL TREATMENT

PROFESSIONAL STAFF

We only employ professionally qualified, clinical staff. All our counsellors have at least a Masters in psychology, and all other staff have mental health qualifications and often a psychology background too. ALL our staff have a mental health and addictions working background.

INDIVIDUALISED TREATMENT

We don't do 'cookie-cutter' treatment. All of our clients are given a personalized treatment plan, and have access to services up to 12 months.

CLIENT SERVICES

Mental Health Screening – over 80% of clients that come to see us will have co-occurring, often times undiagnosed, underlying mental health issues. Our staff are qualified to assess for these.

Trauma counselling – We offer specialized trauma counselling. Typically counselling can last anywhere from 6-12 months tailored specifically for your needs.

Telehealth counselling – we offer all of our services via Skype for those clients who are not local to our offices. Telehealth programs have been shown to be as effective as in-office treatments.

Groups – We offer group support and group counselling in a number of different areas. Groups can be a great alternative to residential treatment where appropriate.

Residential Treatment – ...We are able to send our clients to our partner programs at no cost to you (conditions apply, and all referrals must be through CIRP)

Family Program – We provide free training, groups and 1:1 counselling to families struggling to cope with a loved one's addictions.
